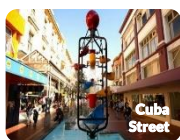

- The deadline for signing up to, changing or cancelling an elective is midnight on the Monday *BEFORE* the week you wish to start/change the elective.
- When you sign up for an activity, course info session, a workshop or CV Check, it is for one time only.
- If you wish to repeat an activity, make sure you sign up for the activity again by the specified deadline in the student portal.
- Some Friday activities may require an entry or transport fee. Please pay at reception before the sign up deadline to confirm your place.
